

UFA Youth Supreme Quest Western Canadian Showring Judging Information

- Western Canadian Show Team Judging The qualifying show must offer a judging competition of at least three beef classes OR offer a Show Team Judging competition. Participants will have participated in one or the other.
- National Young Cattleman Competition The qualifying show must offer at least three skill competitions and participants must have participated in same to be eligible. Examples of skill competitions might be clipping, marketing, judging, showmanship, quiz bowl, etc.
- UFA Youth Supreme Quest entries may qualify from more than one show. They must be the Purebred, Commercial (Plus) or Bred and Owned Champions at your show. **Qualifying animals must be owned by the Junior Exhibitor or their immediate family.** Each qualifying show may send one Purebred, one commercial (plus) and one Bred and Owned entry to participate in the UFA Youth Supreme Quest. Only Champions are invited to participate in the UFA Youth Supreme Quest.
- The delegate or team must be chosen and announced at the conclusion of your show or program. **The delegate must confirm at that time**, whether or not they will represent your show.
- Junior Shows or Programs that have qualified to send for either competition may send one Show Team and one NYC Competitor in each the Junior, Intermediate and Senior Divisions for every 50 participants at their show or program.
- For Show Ring Judging:
participants may only qualify from one show. It is their choice if they will qualify from your show or not. Checking the list posted on the website will let you know which participants have qualified from a previous show. If your show is at Synergy you may need to check with other shows there to see who has already qualified as we will not know those qualifiers to keep the web-site updated. Please confirm that the junior will represent your show before you submit their name to represent your show.
- Division Age Categories:
A junior is considered to be 9 - 11 years of age, Intermediates 12 – 14 years of age and Seniors 15 – 21 years of age as of January 1st of the current year. Ages are calculated by the year the participant was born. Please note that you may only include participants who are eligible to participate in your count to determine number of delegates eligible.
