Junior Show Rules

- The show is open to youth who are 21 years old or younger (as of January 1, 2025)
- Entries may be purebred Shorthorn or Shorthorn influenced
- Exhibitors do not need to be the owner of animal shown.
- Move in is Friday July 4, 2025 from 1:00pm-4:30pm.
 - *Do not move in before 1:00pm. All cattle in place by 5:00pm on Friday to stay on schedule. If that is an issue contact show committee.
- Stalling will be assigned, as some Shorthorn juniors are staying for Summer Synergy so we are making it simple to clean up between our show and Summer Synergy.
- Wash racks and power are available, generators are allowed. Nurse cow pens are available
 please indicate how many nurse cows you are bringing at top of entry form
- Bedding will be provided (wood chips in the barn & straw in tie-outs), you may bring shavings
- Show numbers will be available prior to the show and must be worn in the ring
- Classes may be split due to number of entries at the discretion of the show committee
- All cattle must have visible CCIA tags
- Parent assistance is permitted for the purpose of learning; assistance in the show ring, if needed, is to be provided by an older Junior
- All individuals enter at their own risk. The Alberta Shorthorn Association, Alberta Junior Shorthorn Association, and all individuals present are not liable for any losses that may occur
- Any questions or concerns can be directed to the show committee. The show committee has the final say on all decisions
